News from the Frontlines!

Client J. came in and saw her baby at 5 weeks and 6 days and was not able to continue with her plans to abort, even though she was still considering it. She was feeling pressure from the father of her baby to abort but she came back to see us at 9 weeks and 3 days. Two weeks later she texted us for a list of local OB/GYN physicians. She visited us last week with her beautiful four-month-old baby girl! God can use even the tiniest flickering heartbeat to capture the hearts of our moms.







Sometimes the impact of ultrasound even surprises me! We all are amazed to see those precious little faces, hands and feet in the later ultrasound scans, but the Holy Spirit also uses the very early scans to change the hearts and minds of our moms

Thank you for helping us reach women on the very frontlines, right when they are finding out they are pregnant and making a decision about their pregnancy. Seeing their baby, at whatever gestational age, can make the difference between life and death for that child.

How safe is the abortion pill?

While it is often claimed that abortion pills are safe, we don't actually know how safe these drugs are.

The FDA stopped tracking Abortion pills are non-fatal complications of mifepristone in 2016, and **DANGEROUS** reports indicate that abortion clinic staff often advise women with issues during a medication abortion to seek help elsewhere. Complications from the abortion pill include nausea, vomiting, and serious risks such as incomplete abortion and hemorrhage, with studies showing complications occur in up to 20% of medication abortions— four times higher than surgical abortions. Risks increase with telemedicine prescriptions and when used beyond the FDA's 70-day recommendation. Additionally, relaxed FDA regulations have led to cases of drug abuse, where the pills are given without a woman's consent, exposing her to unwanted risks.



What is it like to take the abortion pill?

Undergoing a medication abortion is a painful experience. A Finnish study found that 58% of women

report "severe" pain. One woman said it was "the most painful experience ever in my life," while another described "unimaginable agony that had me screaming and

thrashing about in desperation and horror." The pill causes far more bleeding than a surgical abortion and may even lead to hemorrhaging. Said one woman, "Clots the size of lemons were coming out of me."

> Perhaps most upsetting, many women undergoing medication abortion may see their unborn child's remains in the toilet or a pad.



What about the embrvo or fetus?

Medication abortion ends a human **life** by depriving the embryo or fetus of nourishment and expelling it from the womb. At this stage, facial features, fingernails, a heartbeat, and brain activity are present.



Can medication abortion be reversed?

It is possible to reverse the effects of the abortion pill.

As long as a woman hasn't taken the second medication. misoprostol, the effects of the first pill can be reversed with progesterone, allowing the pregnancy to continue in over 60% of cases. More than 4,000 children have been born due to this abortion pill reversal protocol. Learn more at AbortionPillReversal.com
